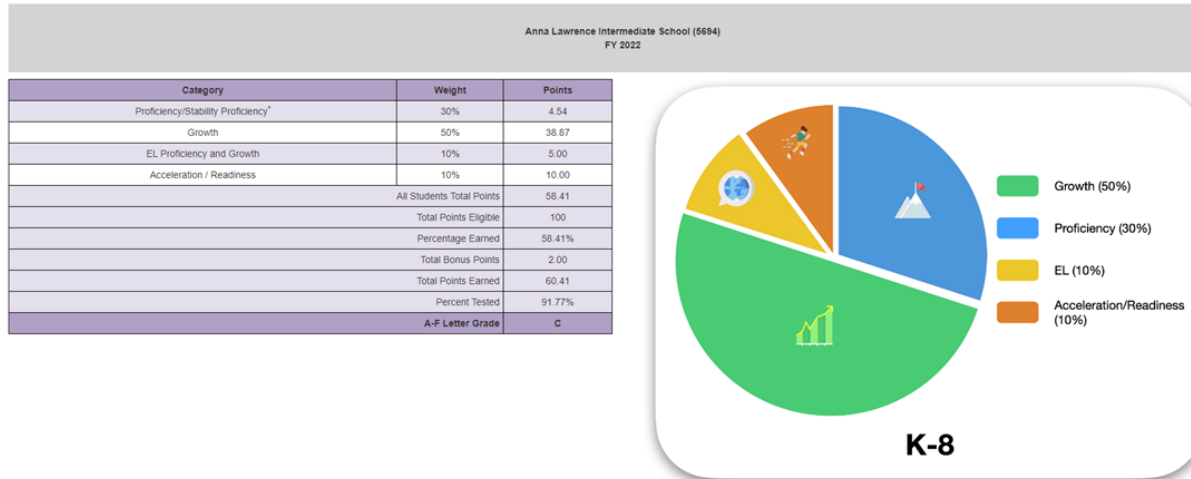

1. Meeting called to order at 8:30am.
2. Reports:
 1. Principal – a) Higher Ground – Works with students, their families, and the community to foster individualized student and family success. They provide a bridge between community services and families experiencing opportunity gaps.
 2. b) Focus – CNA (Comprehensive Needs Assessment) – We currently look at 6 principles with input from our staff on ways to improve staff/student positive outcomes. This process continues into January with Fishbones (Root Cause Analysis) to determine goals for the 2024 School year.
 - c) Spelling Bee – Our Lawrence 3-8 Champion was Bianka Valdez-Nido. She will be moving on to the district Spelling Bee with the information TBA.
 - d) Benchmarks – We recently completed 3 days of Quarter 2 Benchmark testing (December 14-16). Quarter 2 is the only Benchmark test that includes a writing portion as well as ELA & Math. We are confident our school-wide writing

program will lead to success with this quarterly assessment and the ultimate goal of success on the AASA (Arizona Academic Standards Assessment)

e) C Letter Grade – Up to this point, Lawrence 3-8's letter grade had always been an 'F'. This year, our letter grade is now a 'C'. This is based on academic growth, English Language Learner support, the availability of High School credits and ELA/Math grade level proficiency. Our goal moving forward is to increase our proficiency level to have all students learning and demonstrating grade level academic success.



3. Higher Ground Report – a) The Higher Ground staff is appreciative of the opportunity to continue assisting with restorative practices, and the invitation to meet with teachers.
 - b) It is the hope that a Science Fair will be implemented, and HG would be happy to assist.
 - c) HG is appreciative of the continued collaboration with NASS (Native American Student Services)
